# **Barricade Assist Sniper Match**

Each lane will be a stand where shooters will have to shoot a serial in 45 secs then get to next stand and prepare to shoot in 90 secs. Scorers to follow shooter to each stand and record score as one continuous score. As soon as first shooter in each pair has completed the stands, the pair will swap and wait to be called to the firing point.

Number of rounds is 30. 5 rounds per stand.

Max score is 150

### **AWARDS AND PRIZE TABLE**

Awards will be presented to the top 3 in each class with the combined score of the two relevant matches to be used. Prize table will be presented in reverse order, that is lowest overall score gets first choice of prize table and so on till highest overall score gets last choice of prize table.

### Trophy's

**The Bill King teams trophy** – Top 4 scores from each club in the standard service rifle class for the Rifleman and Marksman matches.

**The Dave Kelly open class trophy** – The top score in the open class for the Rifleman & Marksman matches.

**The Sniper trophy** – The top individual score for Sniper match & Barricade assist match combined.

**The Frank Kocsis memorial Trophy** – Top individual score in standard service rifle for the Rifleman & Marksman matches combined.

### RIFLE CLASSES

Each competitor will a nominate rifle for each event at registration.

A competitor can nominate a different rifle for each event. That is 1 rifle for Rifleman, 1 rifle for Sniper, 1 rifle for Marksman.

Please keep in mind that to be eligible for trophy's you will have to shoot the same class in related matches.

All rifles nominated must meet the requirements set out below.

SSR's 16.3.3.1 Standard & Sniper Class : All triggers shall have a minimum trigger weight of  $\underline{\text{1.5KG}}$ 

STANDARD CLASS - As per Chapter 16 in SSR's

**OPEN CLASS - As per Chapter 16 in SSR's** 

Please note that "Modified class" has been replaced with "Open class" this year. Modified class rifles may be used in open class.

Please Note that the minimum trigger weight for all classes is 1500g

### SNIPER CLASSES

**S1** pre-1975 rifles, this includes No 1 Mk3 HT's, No4T's, k98's etc.

Original or faithful reproductions.

Non-issued scopes will be taped off on respective power setting to the original spec.

No bipods but can be rested on sandbag or similar,

No bench-rest style front rests

Stocks to be original or as close to original as possible, cheek pieces as issued allowed Slings as issued or repro.

M40 Type rifles (Rem 700 with 3-9 x 40 scope) are excluded from this class but may compete in S2.

**S2** - post 1975- this includes the Omark, M82 Parker-Hale, M24 & M40, SSG69 etc up to 1995 sniper rifles or rifles that were issued with an optic no greater than 10x. Original or faithful reproductions.

Non-issued scopes will be taped off on respective power setting to the original spec.

Bipods may be used or sandbags or similar

No bench-rest style front rests

Stocks to be original or as close to original as possible, cheek pieces, butt spacers allowed. Slings as issued or repro

With both classes, no specialised rear rests will be allowed although the use of a small plain sandbag will be permitted.

**Open/Tactical/Precision service rifle** is anything that is not included in the above or has a scope power exceeding 10X or is a Post 1995 sniper rifle, things like police marksman rifles are one example.

As per Chapter 16.1.3 Muzzle brakes will only be allowed if they come as standard equipment on the rifles being used. Please be prepared to justify the muzzle brake at scrutineering with evidence of standard fitment to the rifle in service or if possible to shoot without the muzzle brake for the convenience of your fellow competitors.

For the Sniper event, Standard service rifles will compete in S1 class.

Final word is with the organisers, as this is a local club event these rules are final.

Range will be open Friday afternoon for practice.

Self-catering but welcome to use fridges and kitchen area for food prep as long as it is kept clean.

BBQ facilities available.

**Cost is \$85** for all four events & bring an item or group of items with a minimum value of \$25 for the Saturday night prize table swap meet. Feel free to bring extra items as immediately after the prize table presentation there will be a swap meet where you can trade with the other shooters for items of interest.

Powered Camping sites are available for \$10 per night per person and includes all amenities, hot showers, kitchen facilities ect.
